REGULATIONS

- Ecosse Rallye Drivers Club will promote a touring assembly on Saturday 18 January 2025 under a Certificate of Exemption issued by Motorsport UK. Permit number will be obtained and available for inspection at the Start.
- 2. The event is open to all motoring enthusiasts.
- 3. The event will start at the Village Inn, Arrochar at 12 Noon and the finish will be at Dumbarton. The exact location of the Finish will be in the Final Instructions.



- 4. Signing On will take place from 11:00 at the Village Inn Arrochar. Cars will start at one minute intervals from 12 Noon. Individual start times will be issued with the Final Instructions.
- 5. Entrants will be required to have the following where required by law.
 - A. A valid MOT Certificate as applicable.
 - B. Vehicle Excise Duty paid.
 - C. A minimum of Third Party Insurance for all persons who will drive the participating vehicles must be applicable for the duration of the event.
- 6. The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and entry closing date is Monday 13th January 2025. Refunds for withdrawn entries will be at the discretion of the organisers.
- 7. The entry fee for the event is £30 per crew, each crew will receive two rally plates, numbers, and tulip roadmap. All entries must be made on the entry form which should be emailed to the Secretary of the Event, Alan Brisbane alan.brisbane1@hotmail.com
