### FOREWORD

Ecosse Rallye Drivers Club will promote the Arrochar Alps and Col de Ruisg Challenge on Saturday 4 November 2023. The re-start for the Col de Ruisg section will be at 6pm and the Finish will be in Dumbarton.

### REGULATIONS

- 1 Ecosse Rallye Drivers Club will promote a touring assembly on Saturday 4 November 2023 under a Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption for a Touring Assembly. Permit number will be obtained and available for inspection at the Start.
- 2 The event is open to all car enthusiasts.
- 3 The event will start at the Village Inn, Arrochar at 1pm and the finish will be at Dumbarton. The exact location of the Finish will be in the Final Instructions.
- 4 Signing On will take place from 12 noon at the Village Inn, Arrochar. Cars will start at one-minute intervals from 1pm.
- 5 The route will be on public A and B Class roads and unclassified roads. Details of the route will be in the form of a Tulip Roadbook which will be distributed at the Start.
- 6 The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and entry form and closes on Monday 30 October.

7. The cost of the event is £20 per crew. Each crew will receive two rally plates, identification number and a roadbook.
