- 1 Ecosse Rallye Drivers Club will promote a touring assembly on Sunday 30 October 2022 under a Motorsport UK Certificate of Exemption for a Touring Assembly. Permit number 128149 has been obtained.
- 2 The event is open to all car enthusiasts.
- 3 The event will start and finish at Crieff Hydro, Crieff PH7 3LQ with the first car leaving at 1.00.
- 4 Signing On will take place from 12.00 at Crieff Hydro. Cars will start at one-minute intervals from 1.00.
- 5 The route will be on public A and B Class roads. Details of the route will be in the form of a Tulip Roadbook which will be distributed at the Start.
- 6 The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and entry form and closes on Sunday 23 October 2022.
