We have pleasure in welcoming participants to the Ecosse Rallye Drivers Club Heritage Runs which are run in association with Monte Start Committee Scotland. Once again, we extend a warm welcome to all drivers and passengers and look forward to meeting old friends and newcomers alike.

For 2023 there will be a number of new Start venues. These are Blythswood Square, Glasgow, Doncaster, The Old Bell Inn Barnby Moor and the London Start venue. The participants from Glasgow will have the option to leave on 24 January. The Doncaster and Barnby Moor entrants will start on the morning of 25 January and will travel to the London Start venue where they will join with the London Start Heritage entrants and then restart following on from the Rallye Monte Carlo Historique competitors. They will then have the opportunity to continue to Dover.

We would like cars to represent those that would have taken part in the Monte Carlo Rallies from the 1940s through to 1981. We look forward to receiving your entry.

REGULATIONS

- 1 Ecosse Rallye Drivers Club will promote a touring assembly on 24/25 January 2023 under a Certificate of Exemption issued by Motorsport UK.
- 2 The event is open to all classic car enthusiasts.

Eligible Cars

- (a) Cars manufactured up to 1981
- (b) Cars of a later date that were in production during the period stated above.
- (c) Other cars permitted at the discretion of the Organisers
- 3 The Glasgow entrants will have the option of starting on the morning of 24 January 2023. The Doncaster start will be on the morning of 25 January and the entrants will travel to The Old Bell Inn, Barnby Moor where they will meet up with the Barnby Moor starters and will make their way to the London Start.



4 Exact Signing On and Start locations will be issued with the Final Instructions. Cars will start at 30 second intervals in number order. You will be given your number with the Final Instructions. Entrants will be required have the following where required by law.

A valid MOT Certificate where required by the law. Vehicle Excise Duty A minimum of Third Party Insurance for all persons who will drive the participating vehicles must be applicable for the duration of the event.

- 5 The routes will be on Motorway, A and B Class roads. A tulip road book will be supplied at signing on prior to the start.
- 6 The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and entry form, closing on 14 January 2023. Refunds for withdrawn entries will be at the discretion of the organisers.

The entry fee for the event is £39 which will include a tulip road book, rally plates, and refreshments prior to the London start. All entries must be made on the entry form, and emailed to the Secretary of the Event, June Anderson.
